ADJUDICATORY HEARING

The adjudicatory hearing was called to order by Chairman Goll at 7:03 p.m. on January 29, 2007 at the Etna Township Hall. The meeting was audio and video taped for township records. Mrs. Weber, Mr. Cox, Mr. Goll, Mrs. Rogers, Mr. Johnson, and clerk Laura Brown were present.

The purpose of this hearing is to consider an appeal considering the Zoning Inspector's decision that a new zoning permit be filed submitted by Scott Hayes representing Freda, William, and Barbara Langel for the property located at 8941 Hazelton-Etna Road, Pataskala, Ohio 43062. The nature of the appeal is to dispute the Zoning Inspector's decision.

Chairman Goll has received a letter from Hayes Law Offices requesting on behalf of Freda Langel, Trustee, as well as William and Barbara Langel and with discussions with Deborah Scott, counsel to Etna Township that the appeal be continued until February 8, 2007.
