The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on Saturday, April 25th, 2009 in the Etna Township Community Center/Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a special meeting Dedication Ceremony. The meeting was called to order at 10:20 a.m. by President Knapp. Roll call showed Jeff Johnson, Paul George, Dick Knapp and Fiscal Officer Tina Taylor present.

Paul George moved to adopt the agenda. Jeff Johnson seconded and the vote in favor was unanimous.

The Full Gospel Sons, Church of God – Founders – Jesus Christ & Pastor JoVah consisting of Dorrece Tanawat, Rita Antritt, Jeannette Cooper, and Brittany Naranjo sung "God Bless America". During the singing of "God Bless America" the flag was raised by Chuck and Cheryl Hagy.



