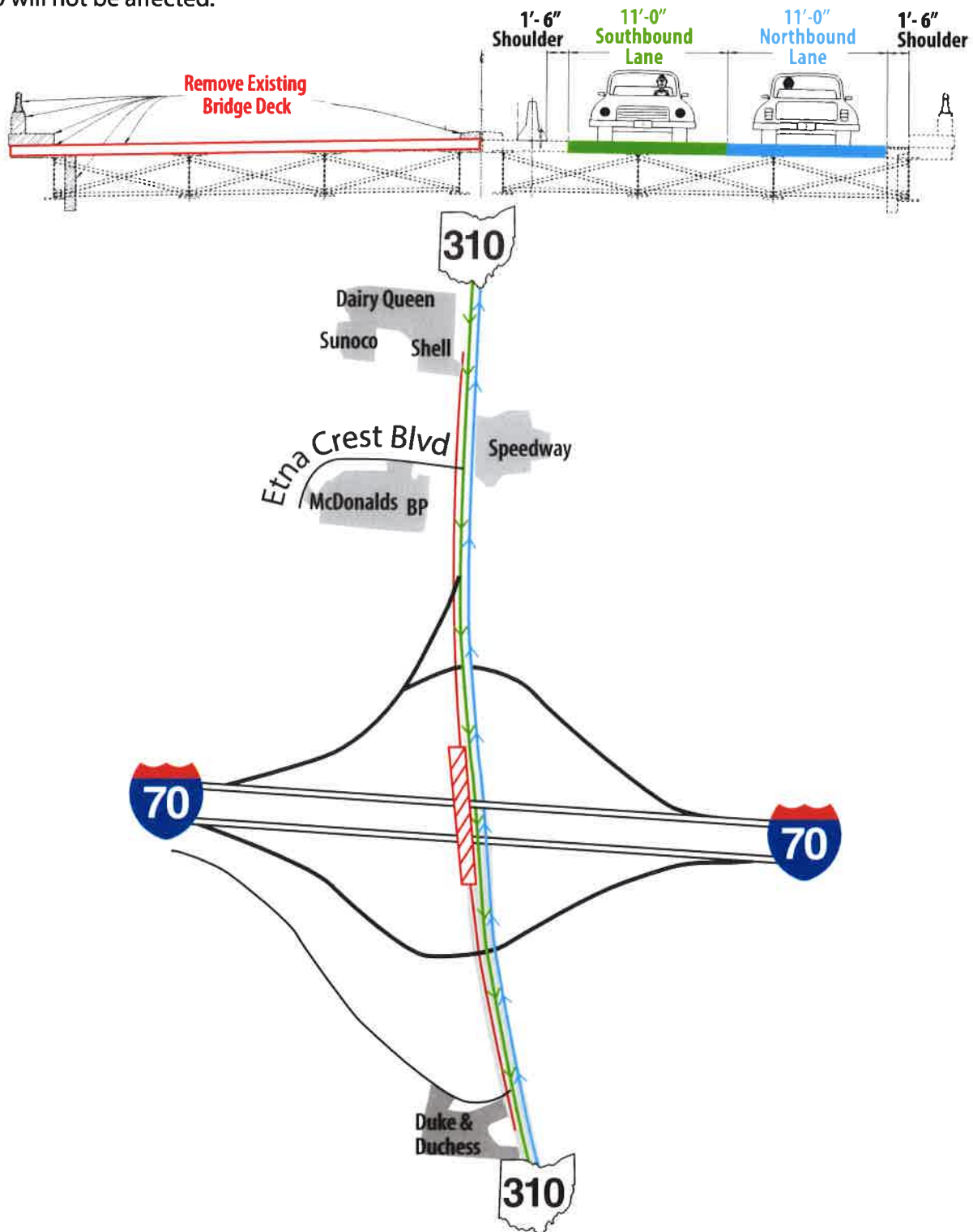




STATE ROUTE 310 AT INTERSTATE 70



All State Route 310 (SR 310) traffic is shifting onto the northbound bridge while they work on the southbound bridge. Temporary pavement was placed on the east side of SR 310 and the raised concrete median was removed to allow enough room for traffic to shift over. Traffic will begin to shift just before the Duke and Duchess station, and return to its original alignment just past the Dairy Queen. There will be one lane of traffic in each direction with no turn lanes on SR 310. All traffic signals have new cameras installed and are on new timings to account for change in traffic patterns. There is a temporary signal in place at the intersection of Etna Crest Blvd and SR 310 to allow vehicles to turn into and out of the businesses on SR 310. Access to and from I-70 will not be affected.

I-70 and SR 310 Work to Begin Monday, April 4th

Jacksontown, Ohio (*Sunday, April 3, 2016*) - Beginning Monday, April 4th crews will start work on the new I-70/SR 310 Interchange.

Work on the new intersection will require nightly lane closures on I-70 at SR 310 for overhead bridge work. Lane closures will take place between 8:00p.m. and 6:00a.m.

The new intersection includes replacements and widening of SR 310 overpass of I-70, widening to six lanes with a pedestrian path, signalized intersection work and the widening on SR 310 with new ramps. The project is expected to be completed in October of 2017.

Drivers are asked to use caution and slow down when workers are present.
