
The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on March 27, 2008 at the Pataskala City Administration Building to hold a special meeting. Vice-president George called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and roll call showed Trustee Johnson, Trustee George and Fiscal Officer Digel-Barrett present. President Knapp was absent.

The purpose of the special meeting was to participate in a community meeting hosted by the Pataskala Area Chamber of Commerce. In attendance were officials from Harrison and Jersey Townships, City of Pataskala, Southwest Licking Schools, Southwest Licking Water and Sewer District, Licking County Planning Commission, Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, Ohio Department of Transportation and Central Ohio Technical College. Also in attendance were Licking County Commissioners Tim Bubb and Mark Van Buren, State Rep. Dan Dodd and Jay Hottinger and State Sen. Tim Schaffer. Facilitator Kordell Norton led a discussion on the most prominent issues facing western Licking County.

The top five challenges named by the group were: 1) planning for the future 2) paying for services 3) regionalism 4) public involvement and 5) transportation. It was suggested that committees be established to address the concerns that were presented.

At 8:47 p.m., Mr. Johnson moved to adjourn the meeting, George seconded and the vote in favor was unanimous.
