Annual Joint Meeting with the Board of Zoning Appeals

Megan Toitch with Ohio Insurance Services Agency will attend the next meeting to review with the Trustees. This resolution will approve the rate increase for the month of March and if the Trustees want to change policies they can in April. The new policy with new benefit changes will be presented at a day meeting also for the employees. The vote in favor was unanimous.
