The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on Friday June 18th, 2010 in the Etna Township Community Center/Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a special meeting/public hearing. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Carlisle. Jeff Johnson led the invocation and John Carlisle led The Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call showed Trustees Jeff Johnson, Randy Foor, John Carlisle and Fiscal Officer Walter Rogers present.

Trustee Johnson moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Trustee Foor and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

The public hearing was to consider a Supplemental Township License Tax per Ohio Revised Code Section 4504.18 for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of township roads, bridges, and culverts; for purchasing, erecting, and maintaining traffic signs, markers, lights, and signals; for purchasing road machinery and equipment, and planning, constructing, and maintaining suitable buildings to house such equipment.

Gary Burkholder 254 Trail East is opposed to this supplemental tax at this time. He would like a detailed Transportation Improvement Plan and more fiscal responsibility.


Freddie Latella 184 Hawthorn Drive supports the \$5.00 license tax. The township needs equipment.
