The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on Tuesday, June 7th, 2011 in the Etna Township Community Center/Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a special meeting. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Vice-President Foor. Chris Harkness led the invocation and Bart Weiler led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call showed Trustees Jeff Johnson, Randy Foor, John Carlisle and Fiscal Officer Walter Rogers present.

Trustee Carlisle moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Nuisance and Junk Motor Vehicle Hearings


211 Olde North Church (Nuisance)


Chris Harkness presented an overview of the violation. This property had a previous violation back in October of 2010. At that time Resolution 10-10-05-02 was passed. The nuisance was abated in early November when the grass was mowed. Chris Harkness inspected the property and the grass is high again. The property owner was not present.

Per the Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87 (c) if a property becomes a nuisance again within 12 months of the Board of Trustees passing a resolution to abate the nuisance and the board deems the property a nuisance again there is a shorter period of notification time and a notice can be posted on the door of the property in lieu of a certified letter.

Resolution 11-06-07-01: Trustee Carlisle moved that 211 Olde North Church be abated referencing Resolution 10-10-05-02 and the property owner has until June the 14th, 2011 to correct the abatement and at that point in time giving Mr. Harkness every ability and financial support needed to get it abated. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Trustee Johnson moved to adjourn at 6:38 p.m. The motion was seconded by Trustee Carlisle and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.
