Rob Platte presented an overview of the violation. The property is owned by Lonnie and Sherri Maynard. The township has received several complaints regarding this property. Rob Platte has visited the property a number of times. One visit was with Mrs. Maynard. Rob Platte presented pictures showing the condition of the property and the debris on the property. The property owner has covered items with tarps. There are a lot of building materials and scrap metal on the property. One trailer was tagged and being used. The property owner was not present but Rob Platte did receive a call from Mrs. Maynard and the property owner wanted the Trustees to proceed with the hearing. Rob Platte stated a few items have been removed and items have been covered with tarps. When Rob Platte met with Mrs. Maynard she stated they own property in Southern Ohio and are moving items to this property.

The resolution provided recommended the following being removed: Yard tractor and equipment parts; windows and doors; building materials; miscellaneous scrap metal (the "Garbage and Debris"); car hood; and remove blue and grey tarp and all items under the tarp.
