Trustee Carlisle requested a representative at the meeting today and they did not send one.</li> <li>The township did not receive a Booking Confirmation letter just an email stating they would be on-site Monday. Rutherford has not provided Proof of Insurance.</li> <li>Trustee Carlisle stated they were not on-site on Monday, just one foreman, Darren. Rutherford Construction is wanting paid for downtime for three days. On Tuesday there were two employees on-site in addition to Darren. The other employees have not been on the job site. Rutherford stated they are at the motel waiting to be called out. On Tuesday and Wednesday Mike Waller did notice someone had been on-site after he had left for the day.
