Etna Township Trustees Regular Meeting

The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on Tuesday, December 4, 2018 in the Etna Township Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a regular meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Carlisle. Jeff Johnson led the invocation and The Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call showed Trustees Jeff Johnson, Randy Foor, John Carlisle, and Fiscal Officer Walter Rogers present.

Trustee Carlisle moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Trustee Carlisle moved to adopt the November 6, 2018 regular meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson. The motion passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

#### Reports

Road Report - A written report was provided.

Water & Sewer - Trustee Carlisle stated the reports are in the file.

#### **Zoning Department**

John Singleton provided an update on several ongoing Zoning Violations.

Fire District, Cemetery, and Parks - Nothing to report at this time.

**JEDZ1&2** - The JEDZ2 Board approved an additional \$50,000.00 towards the township garage. In total they have reimbursed the township a little over \$190,000 dollars.

Trustee Carlisle moved to go into executive session at 7:04 p.m. per O.R.C. 121.22 (G) (8). (To consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance) The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote. Attorney John Albers was invited into the executive session.

Trustee Carlisle moved to come out of executive session at 7:41 p.m. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous vote.

#### Public Hearings at 7:15 p.m. for JEDD4 and JEDD5

Trustee Carlisle opened the Public Hearing for JEDD4. JEDD4 is the CRG property located at the South East corner of I70 and SR310.

John Albers stated the notice of publication for this hearing was advertised in the Newark Advocate on September 29, 2018. All the necessary documents have been available on file at the township for thirty days in advance of the hearing.

There were no public comments.

John Carlisle had a question in the by-law section of the document regarding the JEDD4 Board meeting on January 31st of 2019. This date can be modified if necessary.

Trustee Carlisle moved to close the public hearing on JEDD4 at 7:45 p.m. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Trustee Carlisle opened the Public Hearing for JEDD5. JEDD5 is the northwest corner of I70 and SR310 which includes the Harley Davidson Property, fifty acres of the Snider property, and the Roger Kessler property. This JEDD would be for retail sales. The percentages are still being negotiated.

ohn Singleton discussed two resolutions to demolish two buildings located in Etna Proper.	
One building is located at 1063 Pike Street and the other building is located at 1040 Columbus Street. The building at 1063 Pike Street is at the corner of Mechanic Street and Pike Street. The other building is located at 1040 Columbus Street; it is the paint company that burnt down. John Singleton has discussed both of the locations with the Prosecutor's Office.
