The Etna Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, January 7, 2019 in the Etna Township Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a special meeting. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by President Carlisle. Jeff Johnson led the invocation and Roger Digel-Barrett led The Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call showed Trustees Jeff Johnson, Randy Foor, John Carlisle, and Fiscal Officer Walter Rogers present.

Trustee Johnson moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Trustee Foor and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Public Comments - None**Appeal Hearing****Appeal of resolution 18-12-04-02 regarding 1040 Columbus Street**

Trustee Carlisle swore in Mr. Johnson.

The property owner Shane Johnson who appealed the resolution to remove the unsafe structure on 1040 Columbus Street was present. The property owner is appealing Etna Township removing the structure. The property owner is requesting that he remove the structure.

John Singleton explained that the property owner can reach an agreement with the Board of Trustees regarding the structure. John Singleton provided a current picture of the property. The steel frame is remaining from the structure. The township has letters from West Licking Joint Fire District and the Licking County Buildings Codes declaring the structure unsafe.

Shane Johnson is willing to remove the structure. On Saturday they removed damaged areas and replaced with the new fencing material. The property owner is willing to remove the structure in the next forty-five days. The fencing will remain.

The Trustees need the unsafe structure removed in its entirety. The fence issue will need to be discussed with the Zoning Inspector.

Trustee Carlisle moved to grant Shane Johnson the ability to remove the entire structure down including the steel the fence is attached to until February 28, 2018; if not completed by February 28th the township will remove. The motion was seconded by Trustee Foor. Discussion: The Trustee verified this would give the property owner enough time. The structure will be removed down to the concrete. The motion passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Shane Johnson has already pulled a permit from the Zoning Office for the fence.

Announcements and Trustee Comments -

Trustee Johnson will not be available for the Saturday January 19th meeting.

Trustee Johnson moved to pay the bills as presented. The motion was seconded by Trustee Foor and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Trustee Foor moved to adjourn at 5:28 p.m. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.
