ADJUDICATORY HEARING

The purpose of this hearing is to consider a variance for the required setback distance for 7503 Refugee Road submitted by David Ackerman. David Ackerman stated the distance is measured from a survey. The first measurements Rona provided were probable from the middle of the road and not done from the survey. The house can not be moved back because of an existing garage.

Stan Robinson stated the only reason they need a variance is because the house is in the agriculture district. He feels the new house is improving the neighborhood.
