The Etna Township Zoning Commission met in the Etna Township Hall on December 20, 2006 for the purpose of conducting a regular meeting and render decisions on two text amendment applications. The hearing was audio taped for the township records.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Vice Chairman Dunlap with the following members present: Mrs. Dunlap, Mrs. Taylor, Mr. Stepp, Mr. VanDyne, Mrs. Munce (arrived late), and Clerk Laura Brown. Vince Colburn was absent.

Mr. VanDyne moved that we adopt the agenda with flexibility. Taylor seconded. Roll call: Motion passed 4-0.

The December 6, 2006 minutes will be approved at the January 3, 2007 meeting after review by the Zoning Commission.

### **Decisions from Public Hearings**

A. <u>Section 1401</u> Definition of Junk Motor Vehicles and <u>Section 1402</u> Notifications of Property Owner.

The Zoning Commission reviewed the opinion from the Prosecutor's office. The Zoning Commission felt the opinion would make the zoning resolution less restrictive and not more restrictive.

Jim VanDyne moved to recommend to the Board of Trustees to approve the text amendments on Section 1401 Definition of Junk Motor Vehicles and Section 1402 Notifications of Property Owner. Stepp seconded. Motion passed 4-0. The legal opinion will be part of the Trustees packet for their public hearing.

### Section 1401 Definition of Junk Motor Vehicles

For the purpose of this section, "junk motor vehicle" means any motor vehicle, which meets any or all of the following:

1. Without current license plates and registration or

2. Extensively damaged, such damage including but not limited to any of the following: missing wheels, tires, motor, or transmission or

3. Apparently inoperable, that is left uncovered by not being housed in an enclosed garage or accessory building other suitable structure, in the open on private property for more than seventy-two (72) hours with the permission of the person having the right to the possession of the property, except if the person is operating a junk yard or scrap metal processing facility licensed under authority of Section 4737.05 to 4737.12 of the Ohio Revised Code; or regulated under other sections of this Zoning Resolution.

## Section 1402 Notification of Property Owner

After determining that a motor vehicle fits the definitions stated in Section 1401, the zoning inspector shall notify the person having the right to the possession of the property on which the junk motor vehicle is located that a violation has occurred. The notification may be delivered in person, or may be sent by certified mail with return receipt requested. The notice shall state that within ten (10) days of receipt of the notice, the junk motor vehicle shall be covered by being housed in an enclosed garage or accessory building other suitable structure, or shall be removed from the property.

Business - 2, and General Business 3.

Vice Chairman Dunlap read from parts of the legal opinion from the prosecutor's office. Zoning Commission discussed their options. If the text amendment passes then all of properties currently zoned General Business will be converted to General Business – 1 (GB1). The Zoning Commission discussed the process the property owner will have to change from General Business – 1 to General Business 2 or 3. The Zoning Commission discussed whether to charge a property owner to ask for this change. The Zoning Commission does not have authority to regulate fees. The inequity is because the property owner has General Business Zoning and going from General Business – 1 to General Business – 2 is more like a reclassification. In all of the General Business 1, 2, and 3 the property owner will have all the same uses. The height requirement was discussed and the property owner can apply for a variance for taller buildings. Trent Stepp suggested we limit the building size to retail wholesale only.

The Zoning Commission discussed NAICS Code under Wholesale Trade 424520 Livestock Merchant Wholesalers and under Public Administration 922140 Correctional Institutions. The Zoning Commission discussed having live stock versus processing the animals. Jim Van yne stated they are state regulated that few people want to have them. Zanesville and Mt. Vernon are the closest ones and they sell once a week with an average of 350 animals a day. The Zoning Commission decided to leave the livestock code in. After discussion the Zoning Commission decided to remove the 922140 Correctional Institutions code.

Trent suggested limiting to wholesale and retail. The Zoning Commission discussed. Tina Taylor moved to recess at 8:00 to draft the motion. VanDyne seconded. Passed 5-0. The Zoning Commission was back from recess at 8:26.

The Zoning Commission reviewed the motion and decided to make more adjustments.

Dee Dunlap moved to recess at 8:30. Munce seconded. Passed 5-0. The Zoning Commission was back from recess at 8:45.

The Zoning Commission discussed whether a Sheriff's office is considered a correctional institution. The police station could fall under governmental buildings. It was decided to go ahead and remove the correctional institution.

Trent Stepp moved to recommend to the Board of Trustees to approve the text amendment as described below. Taylor seconded. Motion passed 5-0. The Zoning Commission should attend the public hearing in January and it should be January 16.

To add the building size limits to Section 910 General Business by adding General Business – 1 (GB1), General Business – 2 (GB2), and General Business – 3 (GB3). The Zoning Commission recommends that property owners prior to the date this text amendment becomes effective are exempt from any fees for reclassification of their currently zoned General Business property to General Business - 2 or General Business - 3 and recommends removing NAICS code 922140 Correctional Institutions. All current General Business properties on the Etna Township Zoning Map will automatically become General Business - 1.

The Licking County Planning Commission recommended the Zoning Commission receive a legal opinion. The Zoning Commission obtained the legal opinion and will be part of the packet provided the Trustees for their public hearing. The Zoning Commission is addressing the issue of buffering at their next meeting. The commission feels the buffering needs to be changed in all the districts in the Zoning Resolution to be consistent. The Zoning Resolution currently buffering requirements in Sections 913, 914, 1012, 1108, and 1313.

### Section 910 General Business Districts (GB1, GB2, and GB3)

### **Building Size Limits:**

General Business - 1 (GB1):

<u>Building size limits</u> - Buildings containing Wholesale Trade or Retail Trade permitted uses in Section 910 shall contain no more than 65,000 gross square feet of floor area per parcel in GB-1 district. Buildings containing all other permitted uses in Section 910 shall have no limit on building size.

General Requirements: Within the General Business Districts (GB1, GB2, and GB3)

Height Limit: No building shall be erected or enlarged to exceed two and one-half (2 1/2) stories or thirty-five (35) feet.

Lot Area, Width & Depth: Every lot shall have a minimum width of two hundred (200) feet and a minimum lot area of not less than one (1) acre (forty-three thousand, five hundred and sixty 43,560 square feet) exclusive of road right-of-way and shall be in addition to any easement of

Front Yard: There shall be a front yard of not less than thirty (30) feet in depth.

Side Yard: There shall be a side yard of not less than twenty-five (25) feet.
