Bill Young provided an overview from the Comprehensive Planning Commission meeting on August 18, 2009.

Trent Stepp is still waiting for a return call from Peggy Hall regarding Agriculture Preservation and Rural Residential.

Bill Young moved to waive the public reading and to approve the minutes from the August 5th, 2009 meeting. Randy Snider seconded and the motion passed without objection.

New Business

Discussion regarding towing companies and what d strict the Zoning Commission feels it belongs in. David Goll provided an overview of what this company would like to do on the property on Tollgate Road. He would like to tow vehicles into a fenced in area and house for the legal period of time before he can dispose of the vehicles. The fluids leaking from the vehicles were discussed and the option of having a concrete area for the fluids. There are EPA regulations that have to be met. The Zoning Commission will continue to discuss this in the Article 9 amendment.

The Zoning Commission discussed the Architectural Fleview Sub-committee draft text provided by Bill Young. The Zoning Commission will review and provided follow-up at a later meeting.
