**Public Comments -**


Mike Kerner suggested changing Manufacturing to Industrial with the updates to Article 8.

Trent Stepp requested that he not get paid for this meeting. Freddie Latella stated Trent has been working on Article 8 on his own time and feels he should get paid for this evening.


Freddie Latella moved to adjourn at 9:13 p.m. The motion was seconded by Gil Guttentag and passed without objection.
