The Etna Township Zoning Commission met on October 22, 2019 in the Etna Township Administration Building for the purpose of conducting a regular meeting. The meeting was audio recorded for the township records. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. by Chairman Painter. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call showed the following members present: Litichia McIntyre, Dave Olson, Mark Painter, Lisa Loudenslager, Josh DiYanni, and clerk Laura Brown.

Josh DiYanni moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Litichia McIntyre and passed without objection.

Zoning Commission Announcements and Comments –

John Singleton reviewed the upcoming public hearings.

Mark Painter moved to approve the September 10, 2019 minutes. The motion was seconded by Josh DiYanni and passed without objection.

Old Business

The Zoning Commission and Zoning Inspector John Singleton held a work session on Article 16 Buffering, Landscaping, and Resource Preservation. The commission reviewed the current text and provided recommended revisions.

New Business

John Singleton reviewed two text amendments.

The first recommendation discussed was to modify Section 1103 Paving to change "The required number of parking spaces as set forth in Section 1102 and 1117" to "All parking and loading spaces, and vehicular storage areas".

The second recommendation discussed was to modify Section 2001 Definitions regarding the definition of family. The recommended definition would be "a collective body of persons who live in one house under one head or management."

The Zoning Commission will start the process on these modifications to the Zoning Resolution.
