The Etna Township Zoning Commission met on June 14, 2022, in the Etna Township Hall for the purpose of conducting a regular meeting. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Chairman DiYanni. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call showed the following members present: Litichia McIntyre, Dave Olson, Josh DiYanni, Steven Smith, and clerk Laura Brown. Roger Hayes was excused.

Dave Olson moved to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Litichia McIntyre and passed without objection.

Announcements –

John Singleton provided an update on the public hearing for the text amendment to Article 18 – Planned Residential District (PRCD) from the Board of Trustees meeting regarding the Licking County Planning Commission suggestion to remove the entire Section k on the interconnections because that is governed by Licking County. This recommendation will be addressed in the future.

Minutes

Litichia McIntyre moved to waive the public reading and to approve the minutes from the May 24, 2022. The motion was seconded by Steven Smith and passed without objection.

Old Business –

The Zoning Commission continued working on the NAICS Codes in the General Business section reviewing the index entries under each “other” code and excluding the uses that do not fit. The following will be removed: 238190 Other Foundation – Cathodic Protection; 238290 Other Building - dismantling large-scale machinery and equipment; 238390 All Other Specialty Trade Contractors – Asphalt coating and sealing residential and commercial parking lot, driving paving or sealing, and parking lot paving and sealing; 423110 Automobile and Other Motor Vehicle – Used car merchant wholesalers; and 423390 Other Construction Materials. When discussing the section 423390 it was decided to move all of the wholesale trade section over to conditional use and still exclude the uses that do not fit permitted or conditional.
