TYPES OF SPECIAL HAULING PERMITS

1. TRIP (SHP-1T) - \$10.00

The TRIP Permit provides for a single movement of one vehicle and load(s) over one specific route within a four (4) day period. Special provisions required such as signage escorts, etc. will be specified in the permit.

2. POSTED ROAD (SHP-1PR) - \$100.00

Posted Road Permit allows the holder to travel on Township Roads that have been posted "50% REDUCTION" in Etna Township, for the purpose of delivery/transport of: aggregate, concrete, asphalt, building supplies, refuse, construction equipment and/or any construction-related material to a job-site or lot, and any agricultural equipment or agricultural material. ORIGINAL permit must be in vehicle at all times accompanied by the township-issued sticker. The sticker is to be adhered to the driver's side window and visible at all times. A Posted Road Permit DOES NOT ALLOW the use of any other POSTED ROAD as a through road to desired destination or the crossing of any bridges that are posted at a lesser allowable tonnage than the weight of the permitted vehicle described on the permit. Permit holder must travel roads that are NOT POSTED when possible, to reach the desired destination.

Any POSTED ROAD permit holder who violates any provision of the permit shall be subject to having the POSTED ROAD permit revoked and may be required to obtain an individual trip permit for each movement of the vehicle and load(s) for the duration of the posted road season.

REGULATIONS FOR SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT

- 1. The granting of a permit does not guarantee that the load described can be moved without damage to the pavement or structures; although the permit is granted on the assumption that the load can be moved without damage based on the best information available.
- 2. Haulers will be held liable for any damage caused by the movement. Etna Township assumes no responsibility for damages to the haulers equipment or load being moved due to any such failure. The hauler agrees to compensate Etna Township for any damage to a roadway or road structure or appurtenances thereto and also to hold Etna Township harmless from all claims, damages or proceeding of any kind and from all responsibility for personal injury or property damage (public or private) caused directly or indirectly as a result of the transportation of said vehicle or object.
- 3. The applicant must file a bond or a certificate of his liability insurance, showing that he has procured adequate bond or insurance to cover the provisions of paragraph two and in no case shall be less than \$300,000 bodily injury and \$100,000 property damage.
- 4. This permit shall be carried in the vehicle or combination of vehicles to which it refers and shall be open to inspection by any police officer or employee of Etna Township.
- 5. The permission granted restricts the movement of the vehicle or object to the highways specified between points designated and within the time allotted.
- 6. Oversize or overweight loads shall be operated or moved at such speeds and in such manner as to cause a minimum of interference with other traffic and minimum impact stresses on structures and pavements. No such movement is to exceed 40 mph at any time, except on that portion of highway where the posted minimum speed is in excess of 40 mph. The minimum allowable speed then becomes the equivalent to the minimum posted speed.
- 7. Non-compliance with the general or special provisions of a permit shall render the permit null and void and the operator of the vehicle subject to arrest as provided in sections 5577.02 to 5577.05 inclusive of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 8. Failure of the permit applicant to immediately cooperate in the repair of private or public property may result in the denial of any future permit approvals.
