ZONING TEXT AMENDMENT

Upon final approval of this PMUD zoning text amendment, development of the herein described property shall remain in strict compliance with a Final Development Plan, as hereafter approved or modified in accordance with sub-section 1903(D)(5) of the Etna Township Zoning Resolution ("Resolution") and all general non-district regulations/standards in the Resolution shall apply to this PMUD unless they conflict with this PMUD, at which time all conflicting general non-district regulations/standards in this PMUD shall take precedence.

THE FOLLOWING TEXT AMENDMENT CONTAINS ZONING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE "TOTAL ACREAGE" (DEFINED BELOW):

"TOTAL ACREAGE" INFORMATION:

Size & Location of the PMUD District: The subject property is located on the east side of Hazelton-Etna Road ("STATE ROUTE 310"), south of Interstate 70 and consists of one parcel with the following approximate acreage:

Parcel No. 010-018132-00.000: 133.99 acres (the "Property"), located in Etna Township, Licking County, Ohio (the "Township");

DEFINITIONS

Definitions within this text shall be in accordance with Article 3 of the Resolution.

USE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS:

A surface water delineation has been prepared for the property and will be submitted to the United States Army Corps of Engineers to determine jurisdiction. The surface water delineation identified approximately 2.09 acres of wetland areas onsite, as well as 2,600LF of stream and 546LF of ephemeral channel. Included in the 2.09 acres of wetlands onsite, is 0.72 acres of an open water pond, and 0.42 acres of wetland that surround the pond, which is located within the northeast corner of the property. The open water pond as well as the wetland surrounding it are located within a protective easement and will remain untouched by this development. The stream, ephemeral stream, and 0.65 acre of wetlands fall within a 100' wide Restrictive Covenant for Riparian Buffer. The Riparian Buffer and all of the natural features within its limits will remain untouched by this development. All other environmentally sensitive areas identified on site will be evaluated to determine any impacts by this development, and if in conflict with the approved development plan, will be mitigated through the Army Corps of Engineers or the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, whichever agency is applicable based on the type and classification of the specific wetland.

None of the Total Acreage is located in the FEMA 100-year flood plain. None of the Total Acreage has slopes greater than twenty (20) percent.

The property shall have two (2) established Zoning Uses as defined in this text. The exact final limits of each use shall be submitted by a single or multiple final development plans to the township for approval, but shall in no case contradict the requirements set forth in this text.

The eastern approximate 34.4+/- acres of the Property, located east of the stream to be protected, with frontage along Smoke Road SW, shall be designated for the Permitted and Conditionally Permitted Uses listed in this Zoning Use "A" (Business).

DESIGN CRITERIA: (Whether designed by a single plan or multiple plans, the area shown as proposed shall be referred to as the "Development").

SETBACK AT INTERSTATE 70

Setbacks from the limited access right-of-way of Interstate 70 shall be 200' for any structure; and 30' from the Interstate 70 limited access right-of-way to pavement shall be maintained.

SERVICE STRUCTURES & SCREENING

No utilities, dumpsters, mechanicals or other service structures may be placed in front of the building facade unless existing prior to construction or required by applicable regulations. Service structures shall be completely screened. Service structures shall include but not be limited to, storage tanks, electrical transformers, utility vaults which extend above the surface, cooling towers, trash dumpsters, and/or other equipment or elements providing service to a building or a site. Service structures may be grouped together; however, screening height shall be based upon the tallest of the structures.

SCREENING OF SERVICE STRUCTURES: A continuous (having 100 percent opacity) planting, hedge, fence, wall of earth, which would enclose any service structure on all sides is required, unless such structure must be frequently moved, in which case screening on all but one side is required. The height of the screening material shall be one foot more than the height of the enclosed structure, but shall not be required to exceed 12 feet in height. Whenever a service structure is located next to a building wall, perimeter landscaping material or vehicular use area landscaping material, such walls or screening material, may fulfill the screening requirement for that side of the service structure if that wall or screening material is of sufficient height to meet the height requirement set out in this section. Plant material used to screen a service structure shall be an evergreen species which retains its needles throughout the year. Deciduous plant material cannot be used to fulfill this screening requirement. The height of the evergreen plant material at installation must be equal to, or greater than, eighty per cent (80%) of the height of the service structure(s), and meet the height and opacity requirements within four years. No interior landscaping shall be required within an area screened for service structures.

PARKING AND ACCESS

Parking and loading facilities shall be designed in accordance with the Article 11 of the Resolution, with the exception of the following:

PARKING SPACE WIDTH: All parking spaces shall have a minimum width of ten (10) feet.

DRIVE AISLE: Twenty-four (24) feet wide.

ON-STREET PARKING PROHIBITED: All parking shall be off-street and contained on site. No parking signs shall be provided.

BUILDING DESIGN, SCALE & ACCESS

Each building shall be related to other buildings in the Development with respect to connections, building placement, landscaping, screening, and green space. Store windows and entries will face and be served by the pedestrian access-ways. All buildings in the Development will have a uniform exterior design. Deed restrictions shall be recorded that require that the exterior of all buildings shall be finished with one or more of the following materials: brick, decorative concrete block, decorative concrete panels, stone (or fabricated stone finish products), stucco, wood, hardiplank siding (or similar product). Vinyl siding is not permitted but vinyl products can be used for soffit purposes and such other exterior finishes.

HEIGHT LIMIT: No building shall be erected or enlarged to exceed thirty (30) feet, two stories or less.

LOT AREA, WIDTH & DEPTH: Individual developed lots shall have minimum width of one hundred forty (140) feet and minimum lot area of not less than two (2.0) acres (87,120 square feet) exclusive of public road right of way and shall be in addition to any easement of record. A minimum of 60' right-of-way shall be dedicated for all internal planned public roadways.

Any single-family dwelling shall be a minimum bulk area of 2,000SF of living space. Dwelling Bulk: Dwellings or structures shall have a minimum area of two thousand (2,000) square feet of living space by outside dimensions, exclusive of porches, garages, and cellars or basements. Single family dwellings shall be greater than thirty-two (32) feet in both depth and width.

Building setbacks shall be as follows:

FRONT YARD: There shall be a front yard of not less than fifty (50) feet in depth if fronting along Smoke Road SW.

SIDE YARD: Where development abuts residential used properties, there shall be a depth of 125'; all other side yards of not less than twenty (20) feet in depth on each side.

REAR YARD: There shall be a rear yard of not less than twenty (20) feet in depth.

STREET LIGHTING

All access-ways that provide connection from the public access to and from each building or building cluster shall require lighting that is uniform in the Development and must be of white light, maximum height of twenty (20) feet, placed in equal lineal distances along the private street or access-way with fully shielded downward cast lighting.

All public access ways shall require lighting that is uniform in the Development and must be of white light, maximum height of forty (40) feet, placed in equal lineal distances along the public street or access-way with fully shielded downward cast lighting.

All lighting styles and types are subject to final approval by the Township.

STREET TREES

Deciduous, broad leaf street trees with a minimum caliper of three (3) inches at planting, shall be placed one (1) for every fifty (50) foot of lineal private street and access way frontage on at least one side of the street or access-way, and one (1) for every hundred (100) foot of lineal public street and access way frontage on at least one side of the street or access-way. Such street trees shall be selected from and meet the requirements set forth by both of the Licking County Subdivision Regulations at Appendix VI, List of Acceptable Street Trees and the Township's Street Tree Policy.

BUFFERING:

Buffering shall be designed in accordance with Article 16 of the Resolution, with the exception of the following:

The minimum buffer width shall be five (5) feet in depth.

SIGNAGE

Signage shall be designed in accordance with Article 12 of the Resolution.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping shall be designed in accordance with Article 16 of the Resolution.

Retention/detention basins shall be designed so as to appear natural and not engineered in terms of shape, water level, slope, and treatment of the freeboard. Appropriately sized aeration fountains are to be utilized and appropriate safety measures shall be included in the design.

UTILITIES

Centralized water and sanitary sewer service is available and shall be extended/constructed in the Development as required by Southwest Licking Community Water Sewer District, its successors and assigns. All fire and emergency provisions required by West Licking Joint Fire District shall be provided in each Development. All local service lines for electric, cable, internet or any other utility service provided shall be buried underground. High voltage overhead electric transmission lines are not considered local service lines for the purpose of this text.

Service structures shall be completely screened. Service structures shall include but not be limited to, storage tanks, electrical transformers, utility vaults which extend above the surface, cooling towers, trash dumpsters, and/or other equipment or elements providing service to a building or a site. Service structures may be grouped together; however, screening height shall be based upon the tallest of the structures.

SCRENING OF SERVICE STRUCTURES: A continuous (having 100 percent opacity) planting, hedge, fence, wall of earth, which would enclose any service structure on all sides is required, unless such structure must be frequently moved, in which case screening on all but one side is required. The height of the screening material shall be one foot more than the height of the enclosed structure, but shall not be required to exceed 12 feet in height. Whenever a service structure is located next to a building wall, perimeter landscaping material or vehicular use area landscaping material, such walls or screening material, may fulfill the screening requirement for that side of the service structure if that wall or screening material is of sufficient height to meet the height requirement set out in this section. Plant material used to screen a service structure shall be an evergreen species which retains its needles throughout the year.

Deciduous plant material cannot be used to fulfill this screening requirement. The height of the evergreen plant material at installation must be equal to, or greater than, eighty per cent (80%) of the height of the service structure(s), and meet the height and opacity requirements within four years. No interior landscaping shall be required within an area screened for service structures.

PARKING AND ACCESS

Parking and loading facilities shall be designed in accordance with the Article 11 of the Resolution, with the exception of the following:

ON-STREET PARKING PROHIBITED: All parking shall be off-street and contained on site. No parking signs shall be provided.

A minimum 60' right-of-way shall be dedicated for public access and utilities.

PARKING SPACE SIZE: Nine (9) feet wide by Eighteen (18) feet deep.

DRIVE AISLE: Twenty-four (24) feet wide

BUILDING DESIGN, SCALE & ACCESS

Each building shall be related to other buildings in the Development with respect to connections, building placement, landscaping, screening, and green space. Store windows and entries will face and be served by the pedestrian access-ways. All buildings in the Development will have a uniform exterior design. Deed restrictions shall be recorded that require that the exterior of all buildings shall be finished with one or more of the following materials: brick, decorative concrete block, decorative concrete panels, stone (or fabricated stone finish products), stucco, wood, hardiplank siding (or similar product). Vinyl siding is not permitted but vinyl products can be used for soffit purposes and such other exterior finishes.

HEIGHT LIMIT: No building shall be erected or enlarged to exceed fifty-five (55) feet.

LOT AREA, WIDTH & DEPTH: Every lot shall have minimum width of two hundred fifty (250) feet and minimum lot area of not less than two (2) acres exclusive of public road right of way and shall be in addition to any easement of record.

FRONT YARD: There shall be a front yard of not less than fifty (50) feet in depth if fronting along interior public or private access ways of the Property;

SIDE YARD: There shall be side yards of not less than twenty-five (25) feet on each side except where development abuts residential used properties;

REAR YARD: There shall be a rear yard of not less than twenty-five (25) feet in depth.

ENTIRE BUILDING: There shall be an entire building setback of not less than one hundred fifty (150) feet for buildings adjacent to the south property line where the southern property line is adjacent to residential used properties. Zone B use that extends to State Route 310 & Interstate 70 limited access right-of-way shall have a building setback of not less than two hundred (200) feet.

STREET LIGHTING

All parking areas and truck court areas shall require lighting that is uniform in the Development and must be of white light, with fully shielded downward cast lighting.

All public access ways shall require lighting that is uniform in the Development and must be of white light, maximum height of forty (40) feet, placed in equal lineal distances along the public street or access-way with fully shielded downward cast lighting.

All lighting styles and types are subject to final approval by the Township.

STREET TREES

Deciduous, broad leaf street trees with a minimum caliper of three (3) inches at planting, shall be placed one (1) for every fifty (50) foot of lineal private street and access way frontage on at least one side of the street or access-way, and one (1) for every one hundred (100) foot of lineal public street and access way frontage on at least one side of the street or access-way. On the main thoroughfare connecting the eastern and western property lines, the street trees shall be placed on both sides of the thoroughfare every one hundred (100') feet. Such street trees shall be selected from and meet the requirements set forth by both of the Licking County Subdivision Regulations at Appendix VI, List of Acceptable Street Trees and the Township's Street Tree Policy.

BUFFERING:

Side and rear yard buffer requirements shall be a minimum of twelve (12) feet in depth from the properties adjacent to the development regardless of their zoning/use district. There will be no buffer yards required between the lots within the development. Buffer Yard requirements along public rights-of-way internal to the development shall be ten (10) feet in depth and buffer yard requirements along the public right-of-way of State Route 310 and Interstate 70 shall be thirty (30) feet in depth. The buffer yard along the southern property line, where the development is adjacent to residential used properties, shall provide a minimum 8' barrier of 100% opacity (earth mounding or solid fencing, for example) where there is site development with building improvements. This shall be done as to provide sound protection to the residential used properties. The remaining required buffer yards will be comprised of one of the following options:

- For every one hundred (100) lineal foot there shall be 5 canopy trees and 10 shrubs;
- A six (6) foot high fence meeting a minimum 80 per cent opacity; or
- A six (6) foot high earthen mounding;

All other buffering shall be required as provided in Article16.

SIGNAGE

Signage in the Development and as regulated in Article 12 of the Resolution with the following exceptions:

Major Development Sign: shall be a maximum of 600 SF and utilize the existing poles along the Interstate 70 east ramp (approximately 58' in height).

MONUMENT SIGN: Each building shall have no more than two (2) free standing signs with a maximum of 200 SF for each sign and 400 SF for each building erected within the development. In no case shall any single individual monument sign be larger than 15'-0"x20'-0" unless the building for which the sign is permitted is a single tenant building. In the case of a single tenant building, a single sign may be erected to fulfill the maximum 400 SF allotted for the building but will be no taller than 25'-0" measured from the top of the sign foundation.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping shall be designed in accordance with Article 16 of the Resolution.

Retention/detention basins shall be designed so as to appear natural and not engineered in terms of shape, water level, slope, and treatment of the freeboard. Appropriately sized aeration fountains are to be utilized and appropriate safety measures shall be included in the design.

UTILITIES

Centralized water and sanitary sewer service is available and shall be extended/constructed in the Development as required by Southwest Licking Community Water Sewer District, its successors and assigns. All fire and emergency provisions required by West Licking Joint Fire District shall be provided in each Development. All local service lines for electric, cable, internet or any other utility service provided shall be buried underground. High voltage overhead electric transmission lines are not considered local service lines for the purpose of this text.

Requirements for Fire Hydrants & Surface Drainage:

All fire hydrant locations and spacing will be in compliance with the West Licking Joint Fire District (see attached Regulations). The Final Development Plan shall be developed with the WLJFD representatives' review and comment so that all concerns are addressed. All surface drainage and water quality & quantity will be handled in accordance with the requirements of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Licking County Soil Erosion & Stormwater Regulations, whichever is more restrictive.

West Licking Joint Fire District - Construction Regulations For Appendix A, B, C, and D

Fire Protection Regulations

The West Licking Joint Fire District has the following regulations concerning the proposed developments or buildings located in the West Licking Fire District in accordance with the Ohio Fire Code.

SECTION 3-FIRE HYDRANTS

Maximum distance between fire hydrants is 500 feet.

- 1. Fire hydrants shall be provided no less than 20 feet nor more than 50 feet of all intersecting streets.
- 2. One fire hydrant shall be provided within 150 feet of the terminus of a public or private dead end street, stub street, common access drive, or cul-de-sac.
- 3. Fire hydrants shall not require the opening of a valve for the fire hydrants to provide the required fire flows needed.
- 4. Hydrant flow testing, as recommended per NFPA 291, shall be conducted and documented to ensure that the minimum fire flow is available. These tests shall be conducted at the expense of the owner. The West Licking Fire District shall have the option of witnessing these tests.
- 5. Hydrant and water line plans will be submitted to the West Licking Fire District. All plans submitted shall be full size with scale indicated.
- 6. Minimum water line size for a fire hydrant shall be 6 inches. If the water line is a dead end line and exceeds 600 feet in length or has two or more hydrants on the line, an 8 inch pipe size is required.
- 7. Minimum branch size for a fire hydrant shall be 6 inches.
- 8. Hydrants shall have;
 - One 5 inch Storz connection.
 - Two 2.5 inch inch hose connections.
 - NFPA National Standard fire hose threads.
- 9. Additional fire hydrant requirements;
 - Set depth so that breakaway flange is within 6 inches above finish grade.
 - Steamer connection shall be facing road.
 - Check each hydrant to ensure that there is no leakage at breakaway flange and that water freely drains through the weep hole when shut off.
 - Private hydrants shall have the bonnets painted dark blue.
 - Private hydrants connected to a non-potable water source shall have the bonnets painted white.
- 10. Fire hydrants shall be in service and a letter received from the local water department and a certificate of completion from the installation contractor prior to construction above grade level.

THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO ALL FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY, LOCAL, AND NATIONAL CODES AND STANDARDS
