

Etna Township Community Events Committee

Etna Township is seeking residents interested in helping plan and support community events throughout the township.

The Community Events Committee will serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Trustees and will assist with ideas, coordination, and volunteer support for township events and community celebrations.

Purpose

The goal of the committee is to help strengthen community connections by supporting events that bring residents together and celebrate Etna Township.

Examples of activities the committee may assist with include:

- Family-friendly festivals and holiday celebrations
- Labor Day fireworks and other community traditions
- Events highlighting Etna Township history and milestones
- Community engagement and volunteer opportunities
- Activities connected to the upcoming America 250 celebration

Structure

The committee will operate with the following guidelines:

- The committee serves in an advisory role only
- The Board of Trustees retains authority over event approvals, spending, and contracts
- The Township Administrator will help coordinate operations and logistics

Membership

The township plans to appoint up to 10 residents to serve on the committee. No prior experience is required — just a willingness to help support community events and work collaboratively with other residents.

Meetings

The committee may meet monthly or as needed, particularly in advance of major community events.
