The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President Carlisle. The meeting was turned over to Trustee Foor. Jeff Johnson led the invocation and Jim Duffy led The Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call showed Trustees Jeff Johnson, Randy Foor, John Carlisle, and Fiscal Officer Walter Rogers present.

Trustee Carlisle moved to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Trustee Johnson and passed by unanimous affirmative vote.
